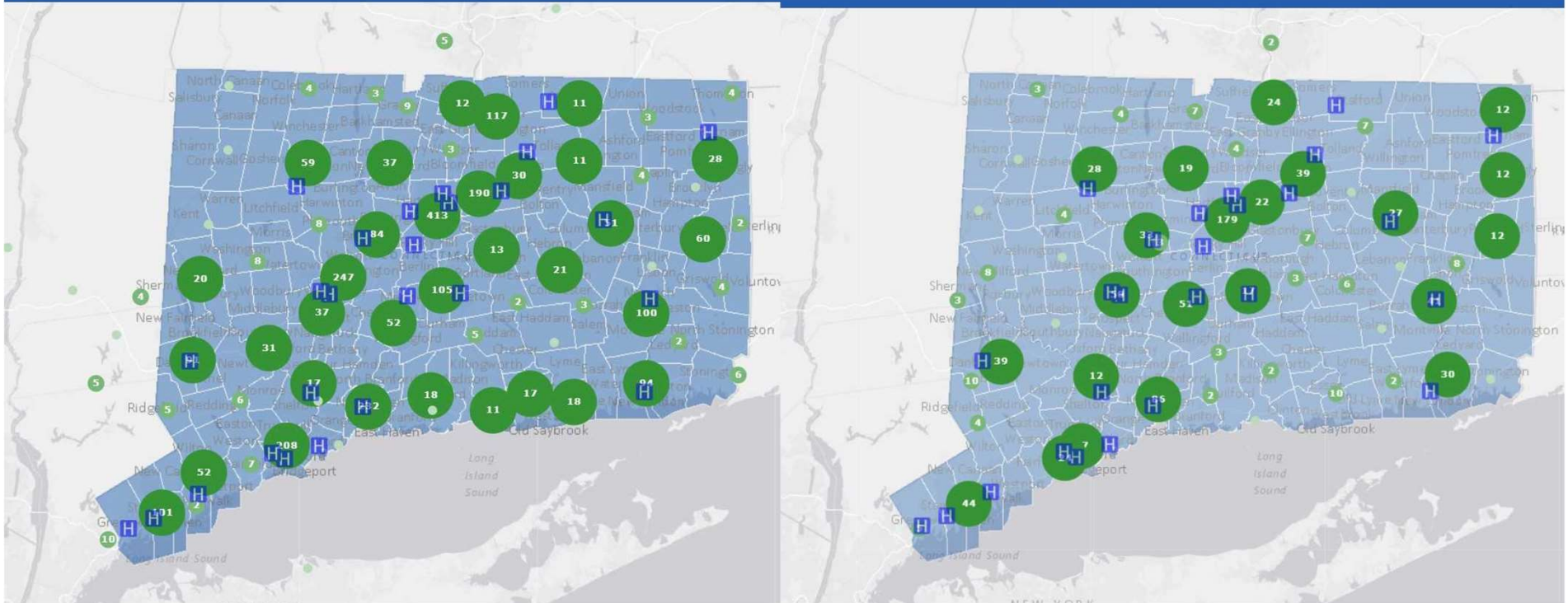

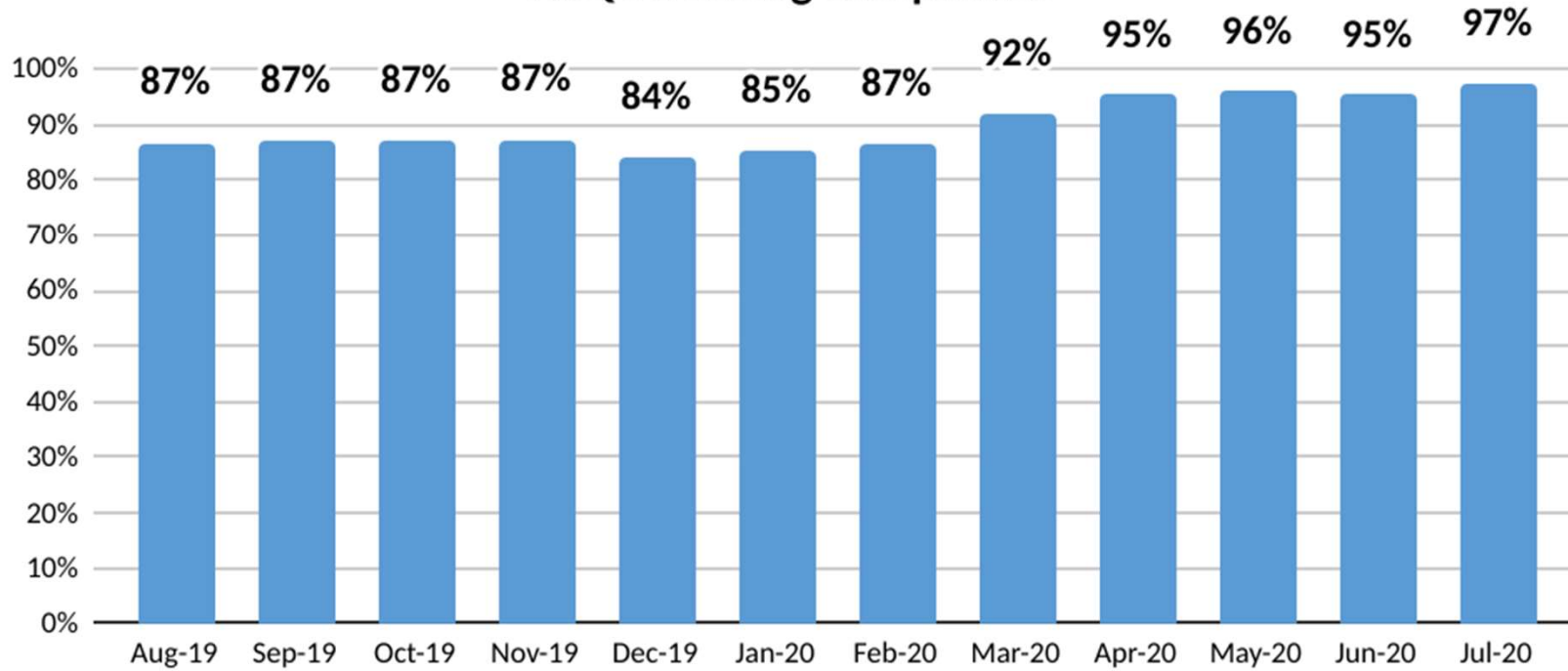


Connecticut Children's Emergency Department

- 89% received ASQ

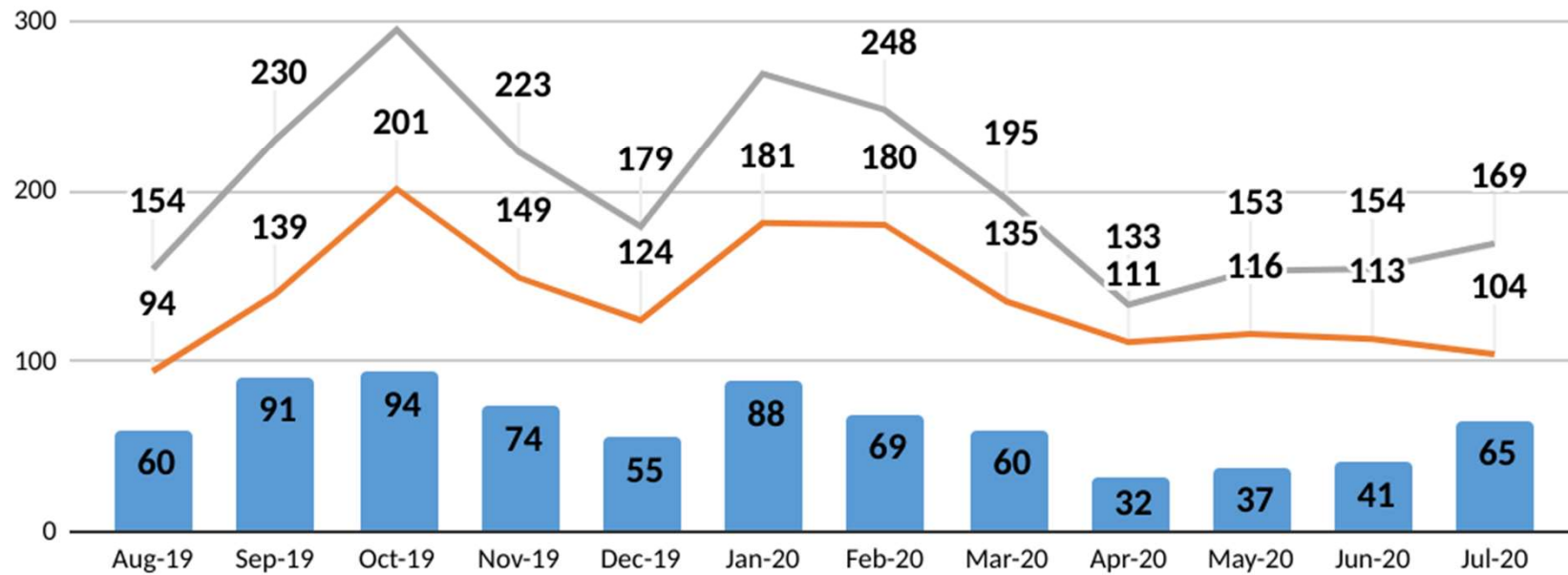
ASQ Screening Compliance
