Legislation to Watch	HB05075: AN ACT CONCERNING FUNDING FOR SUICIDE PREVENTION. Currently there is a bill pending to make CTSAB an official entity in state statute to oversee and help align the suicide efforts in CT. By proxy, RSAB 3 will also become a part of that statute.
