

Instructions for Requesting Display of Firearm Suicide Prevention/ERPO Brochures

Thanks so much for helping us get the word out about Extreme Risk Protection Orders, and how they can prevent firearm suicide. Here's the steps to follow to get our CAGV Ed Fund ERPO <u>brochure</u> displayed in your town.

- Come up with a list of one or more places to approach, such as your local police headquarters, town hall, a community center or hospital. You may want to visit the locations to see if they already have a place where they display public safety/public service announcement brochures.
- 2. Find out who the community or public relations person is. It's your choice whether to call ahead, email, discuss by phone or just show up. <u>We've found that just showing up with the brochures usually works fine</u>.
- 3. In the box you received is a letter of introduction explaining the program, or you can download and print or email (and customize) the letter by going to bit.ly/cagv-erpo-brochure-cover-letter. Add your name and contact information to the bottom of the letter.
- 4. Once you get agreement to place the brochures, point out the instructions for ordering more brochures on the back of the stand.
- 5. If they let you place the brochures on the spot, take a photo to share with us at info@cagvedfund.org. If they say they will put them out later, stop by in a few days to make sure they have, and take a photo to share with us.
- 6. Please complete the survey at <u>bit.ly/cagv-erpo-brochure-report</u> to let us know where you placed (or attempted to place) the brochures, and answer a few questions about your experience. If possible, get the name and email address of your contact so that we can follow up with a thank you.
