 - Is there a regional protocol for accessing the data?
- Data To Action (CTSAB Committee) discuss the different moving pieces and provide updates on a centralized dashboard to help us prioritize our efforts.
- VA death reporting, hospital documentation (there's a gap, only have access to their client data and many veterans aren't connected to their services)
- DPH latest youth risk school health survey
- o Governor's Challenge Suicide Mortality Review (SMR)
